Air District contest gives iPods to students, cash to teachers

Calling all fourth- and fifth-grade Clean Air Champions (and their teachers)!

The Air District is giving away iPod Shuffles to students who sign up family, friends and neighbors to take a Healthy Air Living pledge!

The "Kids for Clean Air" contest runs through February 2009. All fourth- and fifth-grade classrooms Valley-wide are eligible to participate, with prize packages including an iPod Shuffle for every student in a winning classroom plus a \$250 resource grant for the teacher.

The purpose of the contest is to educate Valley students on the importance of cleaning the Valley's air while getting their families and friends involved.

The contest is simple. Any fourthor fifth-grade classroom in the San Joaquin Valley air basin wishing to participate is supplied with Healthy Air Living School Pledge cards. Students are asked to take pledge cards home for friends and family to complete (one pledge card per person). Those filling out cards just need to pledge five steps they will take to clean the air. A pledge can be as simple as never burning trash or riding your bike to work or school at least one day a week. Or, it can be as involved as installing solar panels on your

home or buying a hybrid vehicle.

Completed pledge cards should be returned to the teacher by February 26, 2009, and must be returned to the Air District no later than March 6 to be eligible to win.

Up to 25 prize packages will be awarded to classrooms with the highest participation level in each of three different size categories.

Categories are:

Small Classrooms

- Ten or fewer students

Medium Classrooms

- 11 to 20 students

Large Classrooms

- More than 20 students
