11. The Central Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances:

A. C-20-17E Vitro Flat Glass LLC

On September 4, 2020, Hearing Board Chair, Daniel Hartwig, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 4, 2020, through September 11, 2020. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, and California Health & Safety Code section 41701 and allowed continued glass manufacturing with excess visible emissions while the dust collector, BC-3, gets a new fan after an equipment breakdown.

B. C-20-19E Mid Valley Recycling LLC

On September 23, 2020, Hearing Board Chair, Daniel Hartwig, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 23, 2020, through October 17, 2020. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2201, and 4565 and allowed for the postponement of the compliance source test due to COVID-19.
