RWRF has requested a modification of the previously granted short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, and 2520, in addition to conditions of the subject permits. The requested modification would be for a non-consecutive 14 day period to occur sometime between August 1, 2019, and October 28, 2019, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow RWRF to bypass the scrubbers to conduct the proposed work.
