CERTAINTEED has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4104, and 4354, in addition to conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance period would be for a consecutive 72-hour period to occur sometime between March 1, 2019, and March31, 2019. If granted, the variance would allow the exhaust stream from the glass melting furnace to bypass the pre-conditioning chamber, caustic soda injection, EP, and CEMS while maintenance is performed on the EP. In addition, the variance would allow visible emissions as high as 95% opacity.

<u>Petitioner Comments</u>: Mr. Cuthbertson wanted to clarify that he is talking strictly about the furnace. When the lines are running they have other emission controlled devices on the lines. There are three other EP's that control the particulate matter that come off the lines, this is strictly for the furnace emissions.
