Mr. Houlihan presented the Staff Report

RWRF has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, and 2520, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance would be for a non-consecutive 14 day period to occur sometime between October 16, 2019, and January 13, 2020, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow RWRF to bypass the scrubbers to conduct the proposed work.

Petitioner Comments: Mr. Mulligan asked if the variance would give the petitioner sufficient time to complete the project. Mr. Arthur answered that the project was supposed to go into effect back in October 2018 so they are officially a year behind, however, he believes the variance time is sufficient. Unfortunately, they have encountered major problems such as turnover in supervisors within the construction company, errors with estimations of demolitions and issues with the design of new ducts for the new system. Mr. Hartwig asked is there have been any excess VOC because the scrubbers have not been disconnected. Mr. Houlihan answered that because the old system has still been in place there has been no accumulation of excess emissions.
