AERA has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623, in addition to applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance would be for a consecutive 12-hour period to occur sometime between April 16, 2020, and June 30, 2020, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow AERA to continue to store VOC containing liquids at the Section 32 Dehydration Facility or Penn-Zier Dehydration Facility (PZ Dehy) without a functional or operating VRS while they repair the breaker of their electrical distribution system and install an uninterruptible power supply (UPS) to allow critical equipment to operate during brief electrical interruptions that may occur in the future. In addition, it will allow wells with closed casing gas vents to produce into tanks that do not have a functional or operating VRS.
