5. Emergency Variances:

The Northern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

A. <u>Docket #N-05-07E</u> – International Corn Products

On April 25, 2005, Hearing Board Chairman Mr. Mark Kanai approved an emergency variance effective from April 26, 2005, to April 29, 2005. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2080, 2520, 2201, and 4703, to allow the continued operation of the subject turbine unit without water injection during a start-up period following the replacement of the turbine control system. Additionally, the variance allowed the TREU boiler unit to operate in conjunction with the turbine unit during the start-up period.
