## A. S-20-12E Kern Oil & Refining

On March 26, 2020, Hearing Board Chair, William L. Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from March 27, 2020, through April 1, 2020. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4455, and 4623, and allowed for continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the subject storage tanks without a functional and operational vapor recovery system (VRS) while Tank T-12000 is tied into the existing VRS.
