- 10. The Southern Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variance:
  - A. S-21-35E CRPC Kern Front

On December 10, 2021, Hearing Board Chair, John Stovall, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from December 12, 2021, through December 31, 2021. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2520 and 4401, and allowed California Resources Corporation an extension of repair period while they schedule a workover rig to come to the facility and complete repairs on two well leaks.

B. S-22-02E South Kern Industrial Center

On February 1, 2022, Hearing Board Chair, John Stovall, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from February 2, 2022, through March 3, 2022. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, and 2520, and allowed for the delivery, storing, and processing of biosolids while the biofilter is inoperable until fire damange is repaired.
