YOUR TIP OF THE MONTH!

Tiny particles that are caused by combustion can be inhaled deep into the lungs, which can aggravate, or cause, respiratory illnesses. Traditional fireplaces can emit up to 50 grams of particulate matter (PM) per hour, while an EPA Certified wood stove produces only 6 grams of PM per hour. Pellet stoves produce even less, about 1 gram of PM per hour. (Ref: http://www.valleyair.org)

It provides online, 24/7 access to up-to-date hourly air quality information, automated email or text notification whenever air quality is poor, and specific health guidelines for outdoor exercise. In January, the District launched Version 2.0 of the Real-Time Air Advisory Network that incorporates feedback from users over the past 18 months of RAAN's operation and additional insights from research on the health effects of ozone and PM 2.5.
