Longer, sunnier days and vehicle emissions are key contributors to the formation of ozone – the major component of summertime smog – in the San Joaquin Valley. During this upcoming ozone season, emissions from on-road mobile sources are projected to approach 220 tons of NOx and 61 tons of VOC per day!
