## YOUR TIP OF THE MONTH!

The energy needed to deliver water to your home is significant, and that energy comes at a cost to air quality (air pollution emissions from power plants). According to the EPA, outdoor water use can exceed the amount used for all other household purposes, especially in dry climates, so overwatering your lawn wastes water <u>and</u> creates unnecessary pollution.
