## YOUR TIP OF THE MONTH!

In order to help schools and individuals adjust their outdoor activities to minimize negative health impacts when air pollution levels are high, the District has developed the Real-Time Air Advisory Network (**RAAN**). RAAN gives Valley residents access to up-to-the-hour, localized air quality information via the web, the RAAN smart phone app, emails or text messages.
