During the winter, warm air escapes through improperly sealed areas around windows and doors, significantly increasing heating costs. By eliminating these air leaks by caulking, sealing, or weather stripping, you can save up to 20% on your energy bill and help Valley residents collectively reduce NOx and PM emissions by over 300 tons per year from power plants. Tip: Fireplaces are a major source of household air leaks. Even when not in use, inside air can escape up the flue, so keep the damper closed.
