## YOUR TIP OF THE MONTH!

In the San Joaquin Valley, vehicle emissions make up over 85% of the Valley's ozone causing pollutants. Older, higher-polluting personal automobiles create a significant part of the problem, so the District has several funding options to help Valley residents pay for smog repairs or to replace their vehicles!

Tip: District's <u>Drive Clean in the San Joaquin</u> Program offers Valley residents three options: <u>Repair</u> for vehicles that might not pass smog, <u>Replace</u> for 1999 or older high polluting cars, and <u>Rebate</u> for new electric or hybrid cars.
