

NOTICE OF DESTRUCTION FORM

The SJVAPCD approved dismantling facility must destroy the existing (old) equipment and its engine according to the terms and conditions specified in its agreement with the SJVAPCD. The destruction of the existing (old) equipment and its engine must be within 30 days from the date the dismantling facility receives both parts. The Notice of Destruction Form must be submitted to the SJVAPCD within 10 days after the destruction of the existing (old) equipment and its engine.

Once the Notice of Destruction Form is received by SJVAPCD staff, a post-monitoring site visit will be scheduled by a SJVAPCD inspector to visually verify the proper destruction of the equipment and engine. The SJVAPCD inspector will also take digital photographs of the equipment and its engine, and verify the identification/serial numbers of both parts.
