

“Drayage” According to Drayage Rule:

“Drayage Truck” means any in-use on-road vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR greater than 26,000 lbs) that pulls a trailer or chassis that is used for transporting cargo, such as containerized, bulk, or break-bulk goods, that operates:

- a. on or transgresses through port or intermodal rail yard property for the purpose of loading, unloading or transporting cargo, including transporting empty containers and chassis, or
- b. off port or intermodal rail yard property transporting cargo or empty containers or chassis that originated from or is destined to a port or intermodal rail property.
