

### **Appeal Process**

If a rebate application is rejected, the Air District shall provide the applicant with the reason for denial in writing. Any applicants who feel they have been unfairly denied a rebate may submit an appeal to the Air Resource Board Project Liaison. Such an appeal must be signed by the applicant and submitted in writing via postal mail within 30 days of the date shown on the written denial letter. Please send appeals to:

Appeals made by e-mail, fax or phone will not be considered. The appeal shall contain all facts and documentation upon which the appeal is based. Failure to supply this information shall be grounds for rejection of the appeal. A written response to the appeal will be provided by the ARB Project Liaison within 60 days of receipt of the appeal. ARB's decision shall be final and binding. Payment of rebate funds for a successful appeal will be contingent upon funds remaining under the Agricultural UTV Rebate Project.
