Environmental Justice Advisory Group (EJAG) 2023 Goals, Objectives, and Action Plan

EJAG bylaws require that for each calendar year, EJAG establish goals and objectives, and an action plan to achieve those goals and objectives. These shall strictly adhere to the District's Environmental Justice (EJ) Strategy. Pursuant to the EJAG bylaws, the Air Pollution Control Officer (APCO) shall have the final authority on approving or revising the EJAG's goals and objectives and the action plan.

This action plan will guide EJAG's efforts to assist the District with respect to the implementation of the District's Environmental Justice Mission:

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District, a public-health agency protecting the health of all San Joaquin Valley residents, is committed to the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, gender, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation and enforcement of air pollution control laws, regulations and policies. The District will continue to incorporate Environmental Justice principles in its decision-making processes, programs, permitting, and rule making, as well as provide timely and complete access to information.

The following goals, objectives, and action plan are based on the proposal prepared by the EJAG while incorporating APCO revisions:
