He plays a lead role in critical, health-related aspects of air-quality control, including conducting in-house research and analysis on health- and science-related matters; designing and executing Valley-specific health and scientific research projects; providing expert advice to staff and the Air District's Governing Board in formulating and implementing the District's air quality management programs, including rules, regulations and plans; and working with the District's Air Quality Analyses staff to analyze, enhance and interpret scientific data.

He has an M.A. in Regional Development and a Ph.D. in geography from the University of Iowa, and has published in numerous journals.
