Eligibility Criteria



Grants for **goods movement operators** to purchase cleaner equipment



Emission reductions must be **"early or extra"** to those required by law or regulation



Fleets must be in compliance with CARB's Truck and Bus & Drayage Truck Regulations



Old truck must be **currently in-use and in operational condition** and maintain this condition until replaced




Eligibility Criteria

Old Truck:

In the past 2 years, it must have operated:

- $\geq 75\%$ in CA
- ≥10% in Central Valley Trade Corridor






Eligibility Criteria

New Truck:

For the length of the contract, must commit to operate:

- ≥50% of time in CA trade corridors
- ≥90%-100% of time in CA

PROPOSITION 1B: GOODS MOVEMENT



The Proposition 1B: Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program (GMERP) provides incentives to quickly reduce air pollution emissions and health risk from freight movement along California's trade corridors. Financial incentives will be provided to owners of equipment used in freight movement to upgrade to cleaner technologies through various options for trucks. Projects funded under this Program must achieve emission reductions not required by law or regulation. Please note that the Proposition 1B Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program is not a rebate program. Any purchase or installation prior to contract execution is ineligible. Application Period: Solicitation open from 04/5/2021 - 06/01/2021 or until the District receives a requested total of \$8 million on application.

The total funding amount requested per date is updated every Monday and Thursday by close of business. The District will close the solicitation once the requested funding amount exceeds \$8 million or on 06/01/2021, whichever comes first.





Application Process – Required Forms

- Application forms
- California DMV records
- Copy of Title
- Mileage records
 - A minimum of 2 records showing odometer readings that are at least 6 months apart
- Proof of compliance with applicable ARB Regulations

- Proof of insurance for the past 24 months
- Photo of truck manufacturer's label showing VIN and GVWR
- Photo of engine manufacturer's label showing Serial Number and Family Name



Application Process - Submission

- Completed application packets (including all forms and supporting documents)
- Solicitation open from April 5, 2021 to June 1, 2021 or until the District receives a requested total of \$8 million on application:

Contracting & Implementation Guidelines

After the award notification is received:

- 1. Sign an agreement with the SJVAPCD agreeing to project milestones and completion deadlines
- 2. Purchase the new truck(s)
 - New truck(s) purchased prior to agreement execution are ineligible for funding
 - Purchase a minimum of 1-year or 100,000-mile major engine component warranty that covers parts and labor



Contracting & Implementation Guidelines

- 3. Scrap the old truck with a SJVAPCD contracted dismantling facility
- 4. Submit a claim for payment packet
- 5. SJVAPCD will perform a post-monitoring inspection on new and old scrapped truck
- 6. Upon confirmation, payments shall be made to:
 - The vehicle owner, if invoice is paid in full.
 - The vehicle owner *and* dealership by method of two-party check with a remaining balance on invoice.
 - Note: Please allow up 60 days from the time a claim for payment is deemed complete to receive funding



Contracting & Implementation Guidelines

- 7. Adhere to all program requirements during the project life (5 years or 500,000 miles)
- 8. Maintain replacement value insurance for the vehicle through the full term of the agreement
- 9. Submit annual reports to the SJVAPCD through the full term of the agreement (includes copies of vehicle registration and insurance)
- 10. Agree to allow the SJVAPCD or its representatives to inspect the replacement vehicle upon request



Key Reminder - Application Process

- Submit program application
- Wait to purchase trucks until you have received a fully executed contract from the SJVAPCD
- Stay compliant with CARB Truck and Bus Regulation
- Keep truck registered, insured and in operation until replaced
