2012 Dust Control Training Schedule

The District's Compliance Department has scheduled several three-hour Dust Control Training Courses for 2012. This course is mandatory training for anyone who prepares and submits a Dust Control Plan to the District in accordance with Section 6.3 of Rule 8021 – *Construction, Demolition, and Earthmoving Activities*. Dust Control Plans are required of construction projects that involve:

- Residential developments of ten or more acres of disturbed surface area,
- Non-residential developments of five or more acres of disturbed surface area, or
- Relocation of more than 2,500 cubic yards per day of materials on at least three days of the project.

Who Should Attend: Any individual who represents an owner or operator of a subject construction project or prepares a Dust Control Plan in accordance with Section 6.3.6.8 of Rule 8021.
