

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT  
NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

Notice is hereby given that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District (District) proposes to adopt an Initial Study and Negative Declaration for the following project:

**PROJECT TITLE, LOCATION, AND DESCRIPTION**

**Project Title:** 2012 PM2.5 Plan

**Project Location:** Project applies to all emission sources directly emitting PM2.5, nitrogen oxides (NOx), and sulfur dioxide (SO<sub>2</sub>) located within the boundaries of the San Joaquin Valley Air Basin.

**Description of Project:** The 2012 PM2.5 Plan presents the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District's strategy for achieving the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for particulate matter with a diameter of 2.5 microns or less (PM2.5), as established by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in 2006.

**AVAILABILITY OF INITIAL STUDY AND DRAFT NEGATIVE DECLARATION:**

The Draft Negative Declaration demonstrates that the project will have a less than significant impact on the environment. The reasons to support such a finding are documented in the Initial Study and Draft Negative Declaration prepared by the District.
