<b>Aera Energy, LLC</b> Section 32 Gas Plant Belridge Oil Field	S-12-46S	2070.7.0 2201 2520 4409	Short variance to allow the shutdown of the gas plant which will cause natural gas greater than 10% VOC by weight to enter the fuel gas distribution system.
<b>Liberty Composting, Inc.</b> 12421 Holloway Road Lost Hills, CA 93249	S-12-47S	4565	Short variance to allow the continuation of biosolid composting without implementing three class on mitigation measures, as defined in Rule 4565, and without operating an in-vessel composting system vented to a control device that reduces VOC emissions 90% by weight.
