



## PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Notice is hereby given that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District (District) proposes to adopt an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration for the following project:

## PROJECT TITLE, LOCATION, AND DESCRIPTION

**Project Title:** Kern Front Oil Field Steam Generators by Vintage Production California, LLC (Project Number S-1123499)

Project Location: Kern Front Oilfield, Kern County, California (APN 481-050-34 & 481-130-15)

**Description of Project:** Vintage Production California, LLC (VPC) is proposing to install and operate twelve (12) new 85 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired steam generators. VPC is requesting new permits for six (6) of the new steam generators and modifications to the existing permits for the remaining six (6) steam generators. The proposed project will be located within VPC's Heavy Oil Central Stationary Source in the Kern Front Oil Field.

## AVAILABILITY OF INITIAL STUDY AND DRAFT NEGATIVE DECLARATION:

The Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration demonstrates that the project will have a less than significant impact on the environment.
