**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Chevron USA at Chevron's Coalinga Oilfield in Fresno County, California. Modifications include the installation of 11 new steam generators.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #C-1132740, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 69,619 lb-NOx/year, 23,342 lb-SOx/year, 26,213 lb-PM10/year, 26,213 lb-PM2.5/year, 151,525 lb-CO/year and 45,045 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
