

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION  
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND  
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY  
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Chevron USA, Inc. in western Kern county. The modifications include the installation of two new internal combustion engines.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #S-1140931, is available for public inspection at [http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public\\_notices\\_idx.htm](http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm) and at any District office. The emission increases associated with this project are: 3,554 lb-NOx/year, 16 lb-SOx/year, 58 lb-PM10/year, 58 lb-PM2.5/year, 7,106 lb-CO/year and 1,776 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
