FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Berry Petroleum Company in western Kern county, California. The project authorizes one new steam generator.

The District's analysis of the legal and factual basis for this proposed action, project #1143823, is available for public inspection at http://www.valleyair.org/notices/public_notices_idx.htm and at any District office. The emission increase(s) associated with this project are: 5,957 lb-NOx/year, 3,723 lb-SOx/year, 4,095 lb-PM10/year, 4,095 lb-PM2.5/year, 13,775 lb-CO/year and 4,095 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
