**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Occidental of Elk Hills Inc at Section 18G, T31S, R24E, California. This project authorizes the installation of two new 100,000 bbl external floating roof tanks, one truck unloading operation and one truck loading operation served by a 3.2 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired thermal oxidizer.

The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 2,747 lb-NOx/year, 80 lb-SOx/year, 210 lb-PM10/year, 210 lb-PM2.5/year, 2,355 lb-CO/year and 7,809 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
