**Project Title:** Chevron U.S.A. Inc. Heavy Oil Production Facility C-1132740 & C-1140728

**Project Location:** The oil field occupies approximately 99 square miles. Eighteen (18) steam generators will be located within the Coalinga Oilfield owned by Chevron U. S. A. Inc., (CUSA), in their Fresno County Heavy Oil Production Stationary Facility. Six (6) of the steam generators will be located at the 13D steam plant. Five (5) of the steam generators will be permitted for various specified locations within the 13D and 25D steam plants. Seven (7) steam generators will be located at the 6C steam plant (see Table 1 and Figure 4).

**Project Description:** Chevron U.S.A. Inc. is proposing to install eighteen (18) natural gas-fired steam generators within its existing Coalinga Heavy Oil Production Field located in southwestern Fresno County. The District has received two ATC packages for these steam generators to be equipped with 85 MMBtu/hr North American GLE low-NOx burners (or equivalent, 69 MMBtu/hr) capable of achieving NOx emissions of 7 ppmvd @ 3% oxygen, and flue gas recirculation. The first application package consists of eleven natural gas-fired steam generators. The second application package consists of seven steam generators.
