MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Kern Oil & Refining Co at 7724 E Panama Lane, Bakersfield, California. The project authorizes a new boiler.

The emission increase(s) associated with this project is/are: 1,449 lb-NOx/year, 688 lb-SOx/year, 1,835 lb-PM10/year, 1,835 lb-PM2.5/year, 4,466 lb-CO/year and 1,304 lb-VOC/year. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification. If requested, the District will hold a public hearing regarding issuance of this modification.
