

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT
MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

Notice is hereby given that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District (District) proposes to adopt an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration for the following project:

PROJECT TITLE, LOCATION, AND DESCRIPTION

Project Title: Gallo Glass Company Glass Container Manufacturing Project Facility (N-1161175)

Project Location: 605 South Santa Cruz Avenue, Modesto, California.

Description of Project: Gallo Glass Company is proposing to demolish furnace #3 totaling 14,400 square feet and rebuild it to 17,065 square feet, install three small natural gas-fired lehrs to replace the three existing electric lehrs, and install a ceramic filter (Project). The rebuild of furnace #3 will allow for an increase in throughput of 77.9 tons of glass produced per day.

AVAILABILITY OF INITIAL STUDY AND DRAFT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION:

The Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration demonstrates that with mitigation the Project will have a less than significant impact on the environment.
