Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The amendments proposed to District Rule 4905 extend the existing emissions fee option to allow equipment manufacturers additional time to bring sufficient units to the marketplace and include additional administrative requirements to ensure enforcement of the regulation. There are no other actions or rule requirements associated with this project. Based on the District's investigation, substantial evidence supports the District's conclusion that the amendments will not cause either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and as such is not a "project" as that term is defined under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines § 15378. In addition, substantial evidence supports the District's conclusion that assuming the amendment is a "project" under CEQA, it will not have any significant adverse effects on the environment. The District finds that the project is exempt per the general rule that the rule amendment is an action as authorized by state law for a regulatory agency to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of the environment where the regulatory process involves procedures for protection of the environment per CEQA Guidelines §15308 as well as the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a
