NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to Kern Oil and Refining Company for the shutdown of a boiler, at 7724 Panama Lane, near Bakersfield CA. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 846 lb-NOx/yr, 1,691 lb-SOx/yr, 605 lb-PM10/yr, 22,216 lb-CO/yr, and 581 lb-VOC/yr.
