

**NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED MODIFICATION OF
FEDERALLY MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District has made its final decision to modify the Federally Mandated Operating Permit to Chevron USA Inc at it's oilfield facility located at the Heavy Western Stationary Source in Kern County, California. Chevron USA Inc had proposed to streamline and standardize the permits for the steam generators, thermally enhanced oil recovery (TEOR) wells, heavy oil tanks, IC engines, flares, and turbines by moving the common permit conditions to the facility-wide permit.
