

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of Vie-Del Winery #1 at 11903 S Chestnut Ave, California. The facility has proposed to modify an existing 60 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired boiler (permit unit C-1344-7) to tune the existing Haldor Topsoe model DNX-929 Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) system in order to meet the 2.5 ppmv NOx emission limit of District Rule 4320.

There are no emission increases associated with this proposed action. This will be the public's only opportunity to comment on the specific conditions of the modification.
