Note from Steve Roeder: The equipment that was evaluated for the modern BPS was researched further and found to have had fins. Therefore, the wording of the BPS Requirement was changed to reflect "convection section heat transfer surface area". This counts fin surface area, or tube surface area if there are not fins. The BPS discussion was also updated to reflect this.
