State Law Governing City Appointment

- H&SC Section 40600(c)(2) outlines the requirements for the five city representatives
 - 3 representatives from cities with a pop. less than 100,000
 - 1 from each region of the district
 - 2 members from cities with a pop. of 100,000 or more
 - Must be from different regions
 - No more than 1 city member per county
- H&SC Section 40600.5 Established the City Selection Committee
 - Appoints the District Executive Director/APCO as the Permanent Secretary to the Committee

Proposed City Seat Rotation

- 1. The Permanent Secretary has been notified by the League of Cities that they wish for the Air District to solicit candidates for appointment.
- 2. The Air District Governing Board shall have three members from cities with a population of less than 100,000, with one member selected from the northern region, one from the central region, and one from the southern region of the District.
- 3. The Air District Governing Board shall have two members from cities with a population of 100,000 or more, with each member selected from different regions of the District.
- 4. There shall be no more than one city representative from each county within the District.
- 5. The cities selected shall rotate amongst the counties by District regions, from North to South.
- 6. When possible, members will be appointed for a second term.
