Action Items Summary

Item	Action	Status
1	Stakeholders ask that the District enhance the ability to track changes to permit conditions made through permitting actions. Based on suggestions from stakeholders, the District has created a programming task to enhance our permit administration system (PAS) with this functionality. The District set up a subcommittee (with District programmers) to explore solutions to help facilities track changes to permit conditions. One suggestion is to separate any new/changed conditions by adding to the end of the permit to aid in identifying the changes from the previous Title V permit reporting requirements. In the meantime, a beta permit tracking access program has been developed and shared with interested stakeholders. The District seeks feedback on this tracking program. (Marjollet)	On hold until this item obtains District programming resources
2	Manual Cunha suggestion that a Compliance Assistance Bulletin on the ARB truck idling rule be sent to truck manufacturers, farm bureaus, Fresno Business Journal and truck repair shops. (Lambert)	No longer timely and will be removed as action item
3	Annual Offset Equivalency Demonstration – Put together mailing list of stakeholders inviting them to discuss solutions (Warner)	District will compile list and invite stakeholders to meeting
4	Look into how EPA deals with a test method change including changing ASTM method to another. These test method specifications are included in rules. Industry to provide specific test method examples that are updated or where a better method exists. Explore flexibility with use of alternative test methods. (Garcia)	District sent out reminder to request examples
5	Send out reminder to stakeholders to request examples on permit inconsistency examples. (Warner)	District sent out reminder to request examples
6	Rule 3170 emission inventories for fugitive emissions. District will develop a draft guidance which will be used to determine the fugitive emissions at sources. (Villalvazo)	District has sent draft document to streamlining stakeholders who expressed interest in reviewing and commenting on the draft.
7	Check timeframe status of EPA's approval for Rule 2410 (Prevention of Significant Deterioration). Send out update to group when EPA issues Proposed Approval. (Garcia)	As of 2/7/12, EPA hopes to propose approval in late February or early March, with final approval in late spring.
