GUARDIAN has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rues 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4101, 4354, and California Health and Safety Code (CH&SC) section 41701, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested short variance will be for a consecutive 48-hour period to occur sometime between March 19, 2026, and April 10, 2026, inclusive. If granted, the variance will allow the continued operation of the glass melting furnace, and continued glass production with excess visible emissions, while GUARDIAN shuts down the emission control system in order to perform routine maintenance on the EP.
