

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED MINOR MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authority To Construct to Baker Commodities at 16801 W Jensen Ave in Kerman, California. The purpose of this project is the installation of a 50.2 MMBtu/hr natural gas-fired boiler equipped with an ultra-low NOx burner to provide steam to the cooker, permitted under C-72-3. The proposed boiler will replace the existing boiler associated with Permit to Operate C-72-8.
