

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF
AUTHORITIES TO CONSTRUCT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Authorities to Construct to Silvas Holsteins Dairy for the modification of an existing dairy operation. The modification includes increasing herd capacity from 880 milk cows, not to exceed a combined total of 1,095 mature cows (milk and dry), and 885 total support stock (heifers, calves, and bulls) to 1,900 milk cows, not to exceed a combined total of 2,200 mature cows (milk and dry), and 1,900 total support stock; replacing the existing milking parlor with a double 20 parallel (40 stalls) milking parlor; constructing new cow housing units; installing two anaerobic treatment lagoons; and expanding the footprint of cow housing units, at 6706 Elaine Rd, Turlock, CA.
