## **Air District seeks technology proposals** ***Emission reductions focus of \$900,000 in awards***

As a part of the new Technology Advancement Program, the San Joaquin Air Pollution Control District is seeking proposals for projects that demonstrate innovative, creative, emission-reduction technologies.

Funding is available totaling \$900,000 for four to seven awards ranging from \$100,000 to \$300,000 each. The District is seeking technology demonstrations in the areas of renewable energy, waste to energy and mobile sources. Funding is provided by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The request for proposals opened Thursday, June 3, 2010, and the deadline for submissions is Friday, July 9, 2010 at 5 pm.
