Kids' clean-air art contest deadline approaches Top art to be used in Air District calendar

Fresno, CA - The Valley Air District calls upon young artists throughout the San Joaquin Valley to submit artwork for the 2006 Clean Air Kids' calendar. The deadline for submissions is Sept. 30.

Valley students in kindergarten through 12th grade are invited to enter the contest. Original artwork should be done in color and contain a message about ways we all can help clean the Valley's air. Artists should use white paper and place the page in landscape orientation, so the paper is 8 ½ inches high and 11 inches wide.

Fourteen drawings with clean-air themes will be selected and reproduced in a color calendar that is distributed free to schools, community groups, healthcare facilities, churches and non-profit organizations. Each artist will receive a supply of calendars for family and friends. About 20,000 calendars will be distributed Valley-wide.

Entries must include the artist's name, address, phone number, age, grade and school, and should be mailed flat in a large envelope to: Calendar Contest, Valley Air District, 1990 E. Gettysburg Ave., Fresno, CA 93726. Drawings should not be folded or stapled and must be received by the Sept. 30 deadline.

The Valley Air District covers eight counties including San Joaquin, Stanislaus, Merced, Madera, Fresno, Kings, Tulare and the valley portion of Kern.
